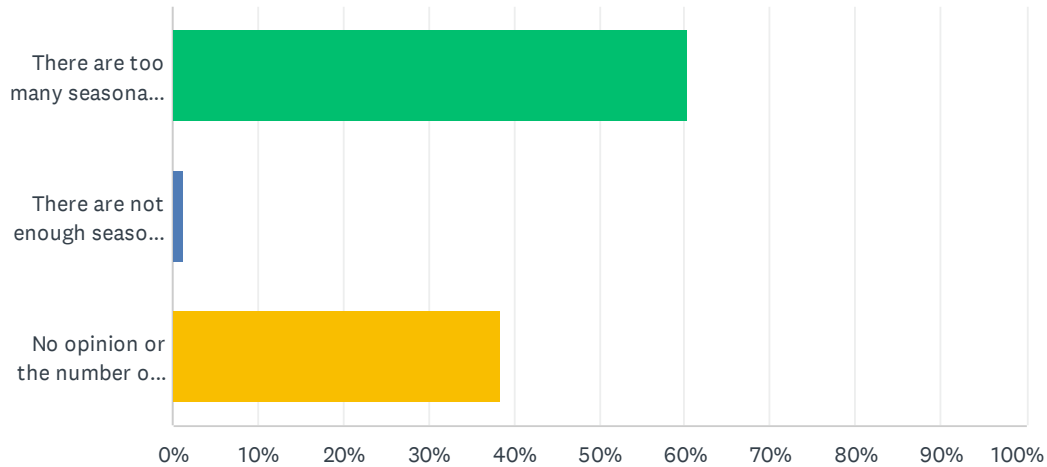


Q1 What is your opinion about the number of seasonal rental properties in Narragansett?

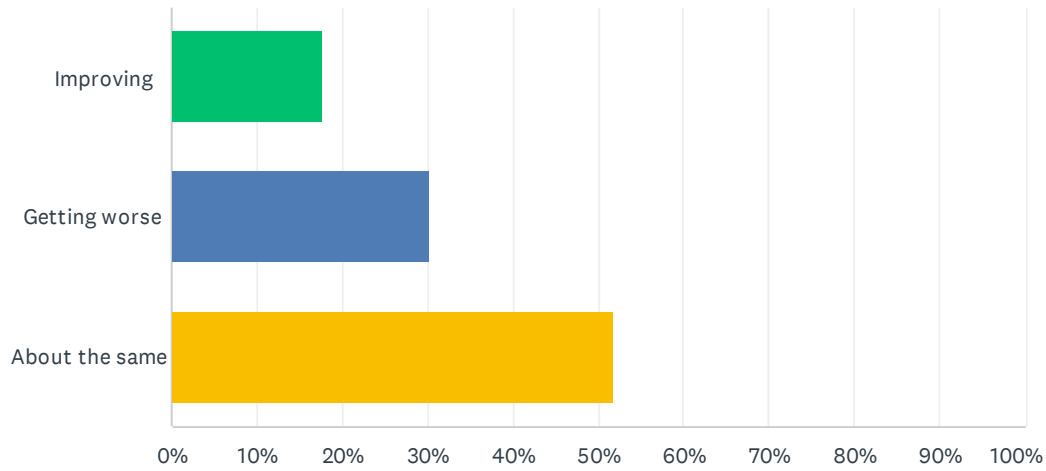

Q2 Based on your history as a Narragansett resident, have issues related to seasonal rentals (noise, parking, parties, etc.) improved or gotten worse over the last several years?

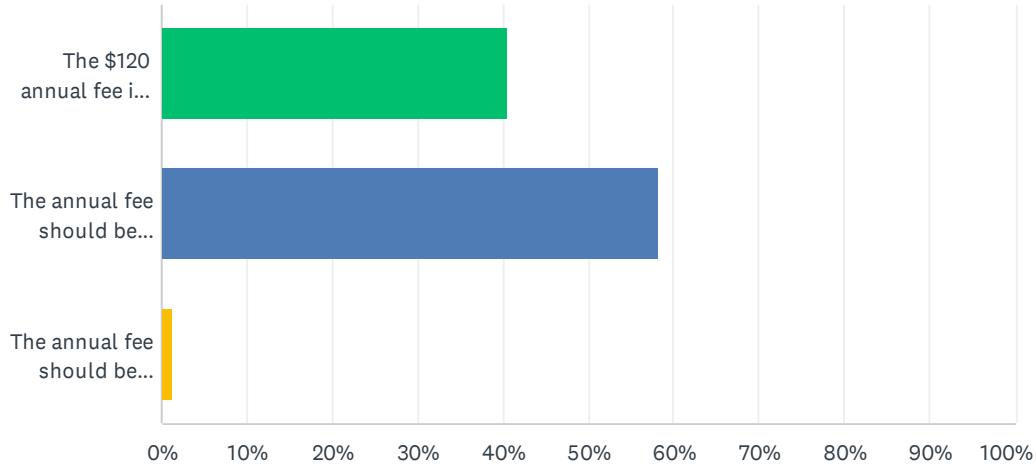

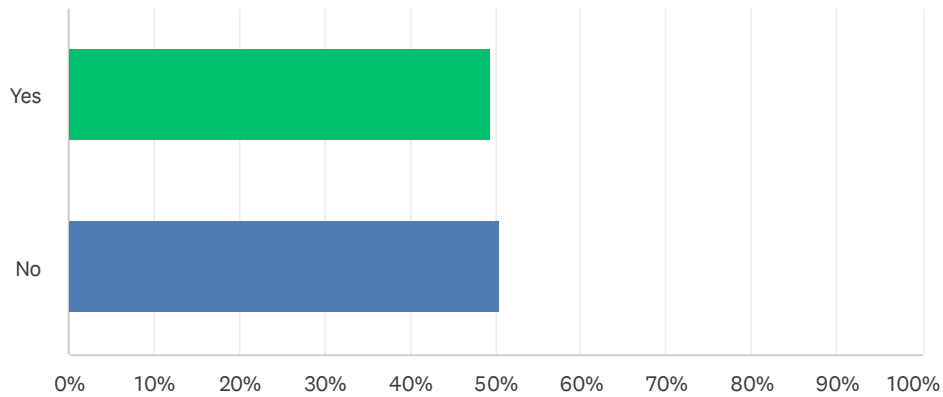

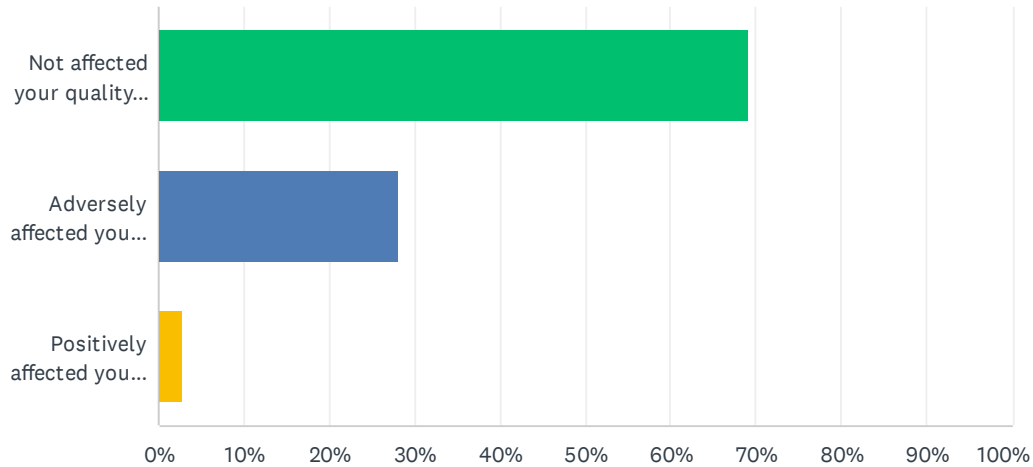

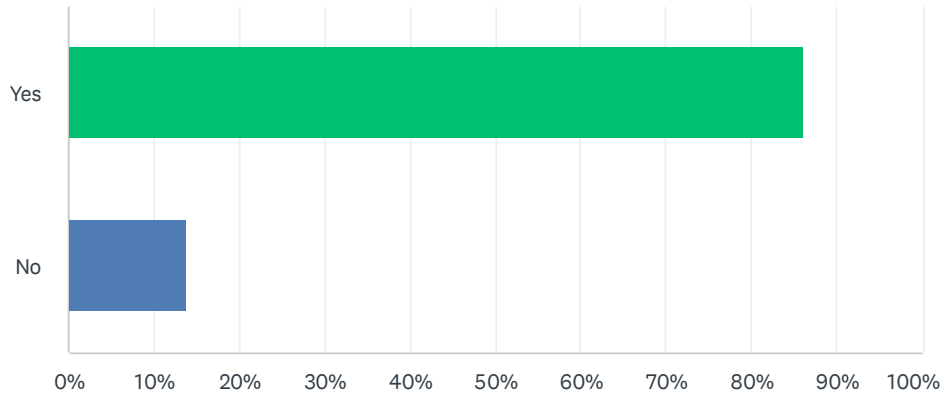

Q6 Do you believe there should be special rental regulations to address short term rental properties (there is none now)

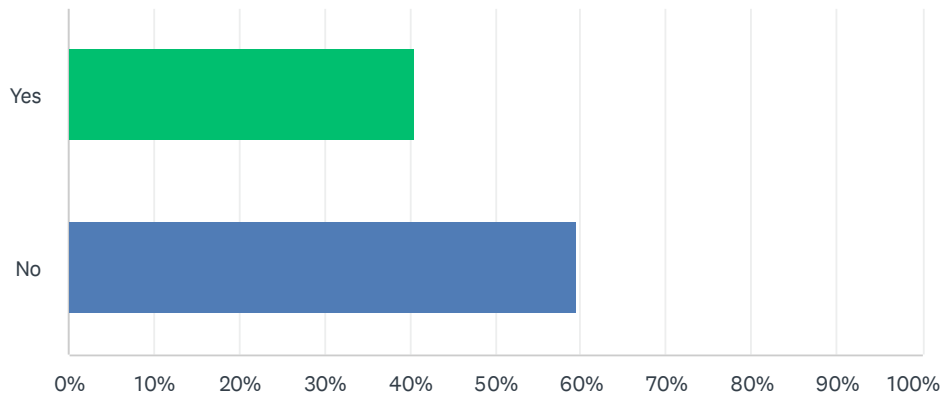

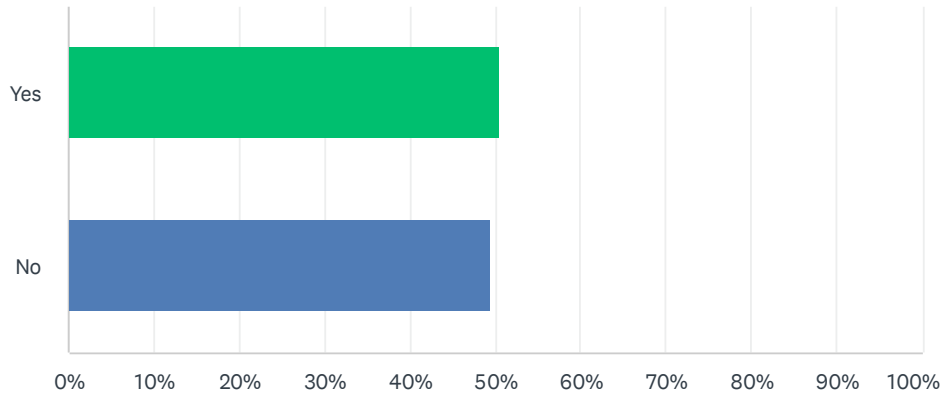

Q8 Have you observed greater police presence this year in/around beach/lots/key intersections?

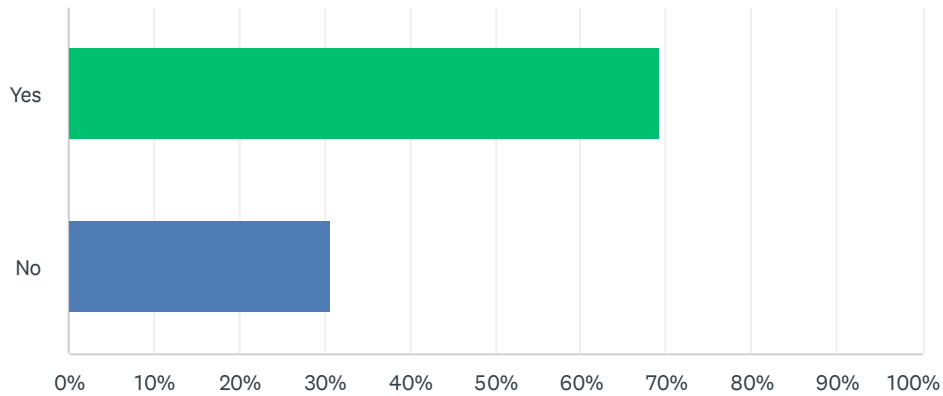

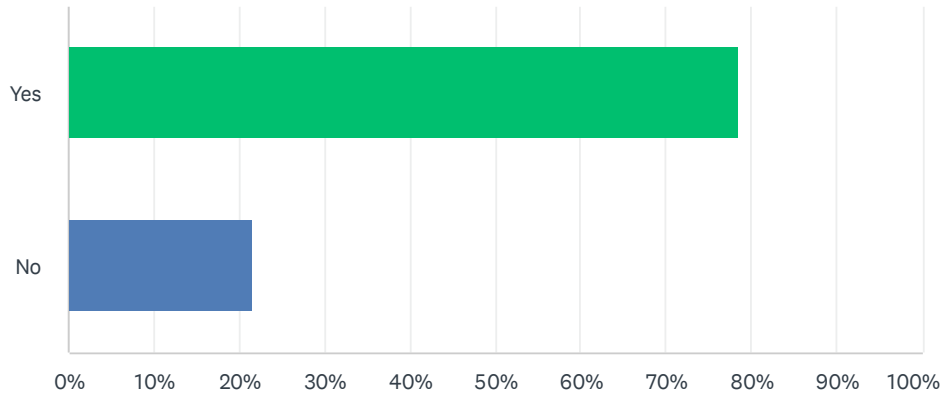

Q10 Is Narragansett your primary residence? i.e. Do you qualify for the Narragansett Homestead exemption?

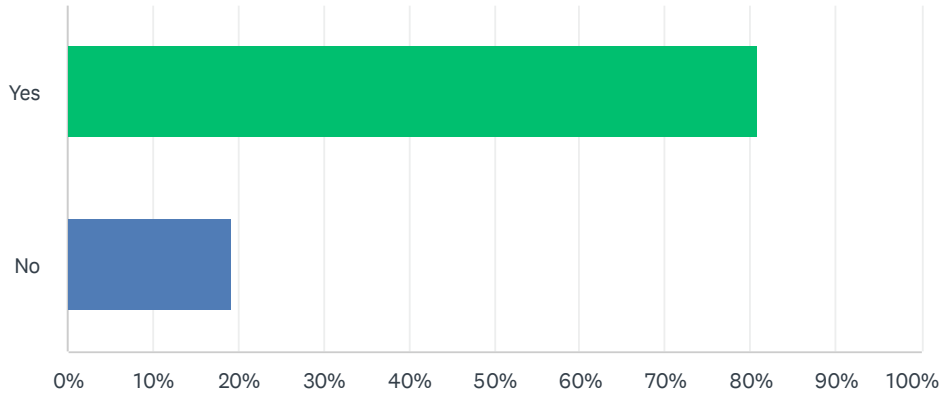

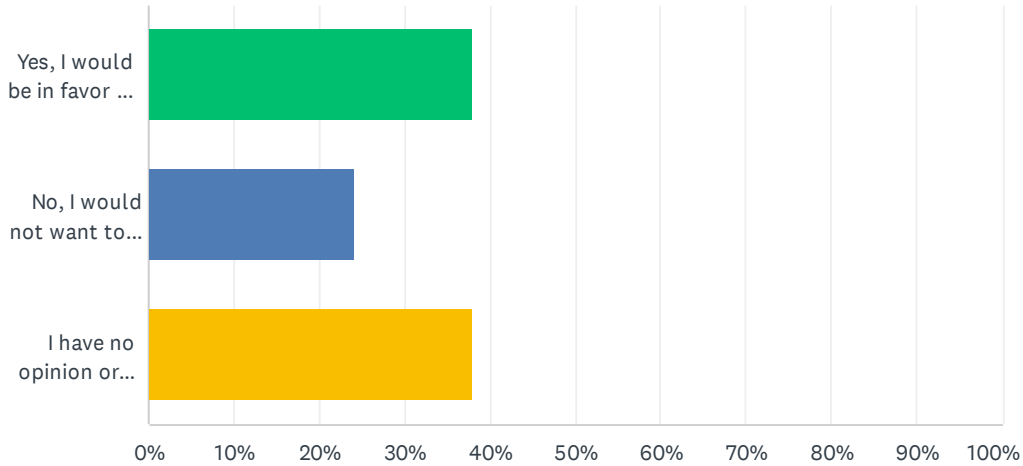

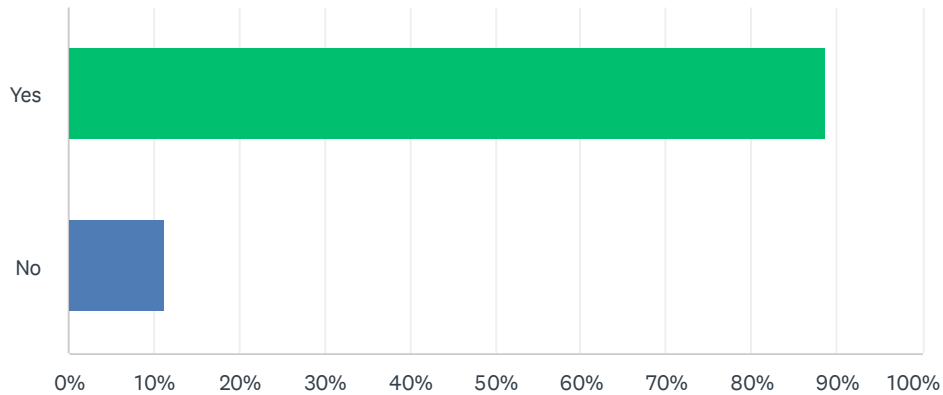

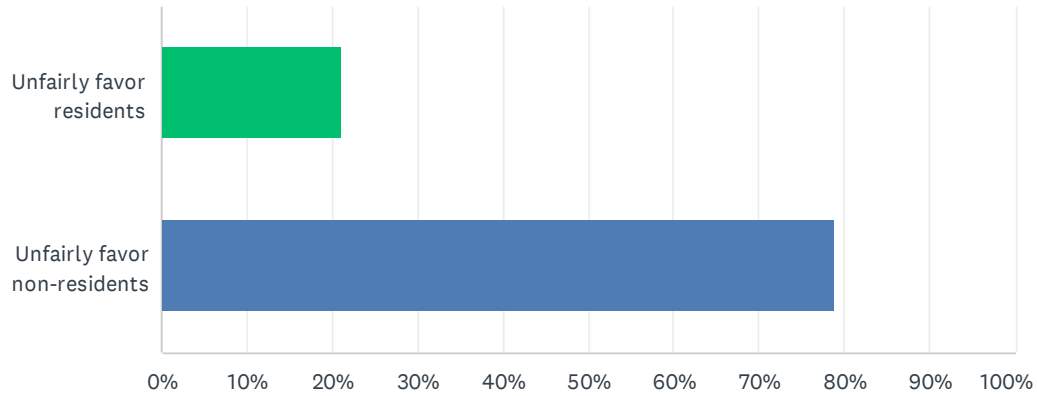

Q14 Do you believe existing beach fees and policies are fairly balanced between residents and non-residents?

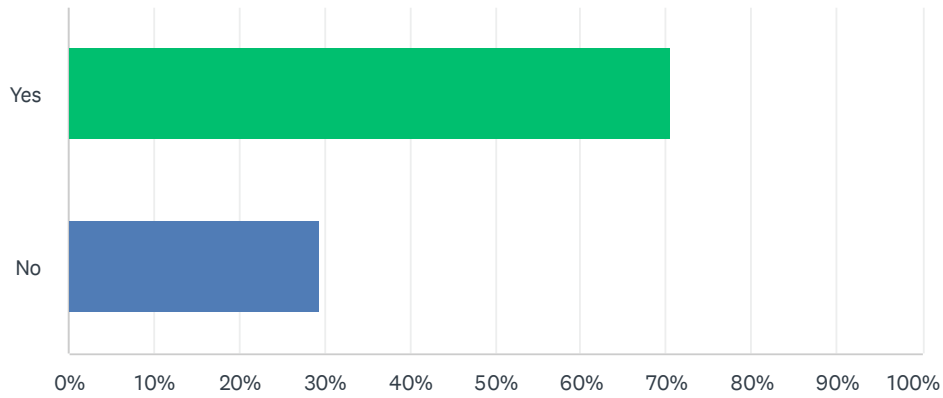

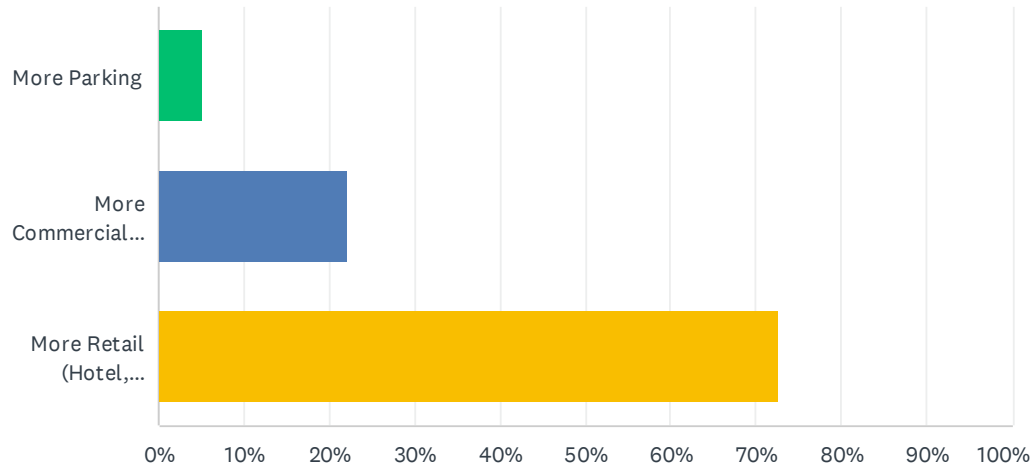

Q16 Which type of development do you favor for Galilee?

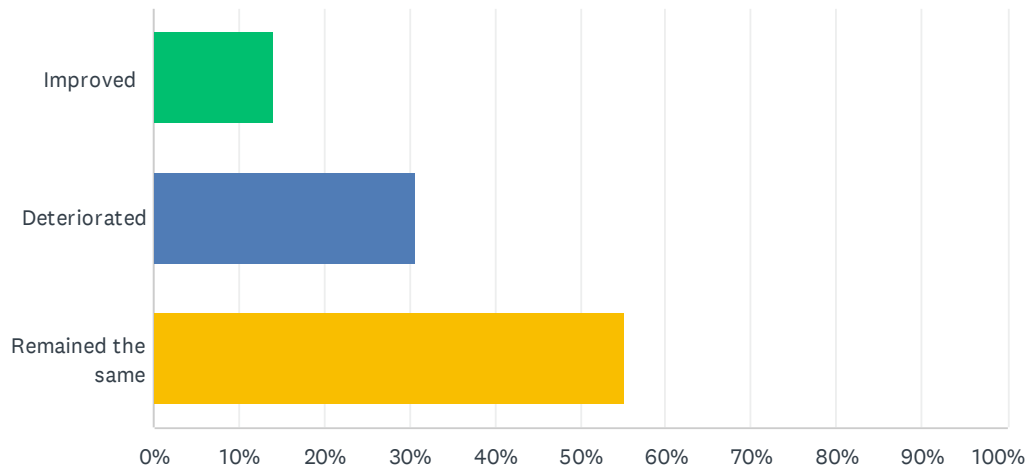

Q17 Have the condition of roads and sidewalks in your neighborhood?

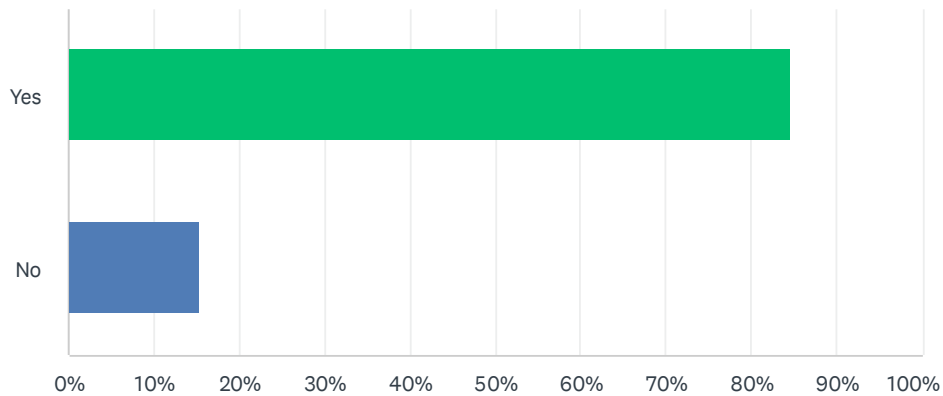

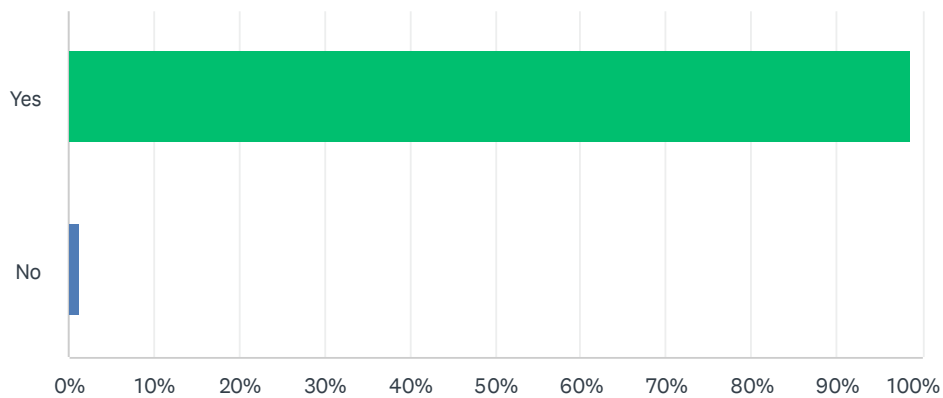

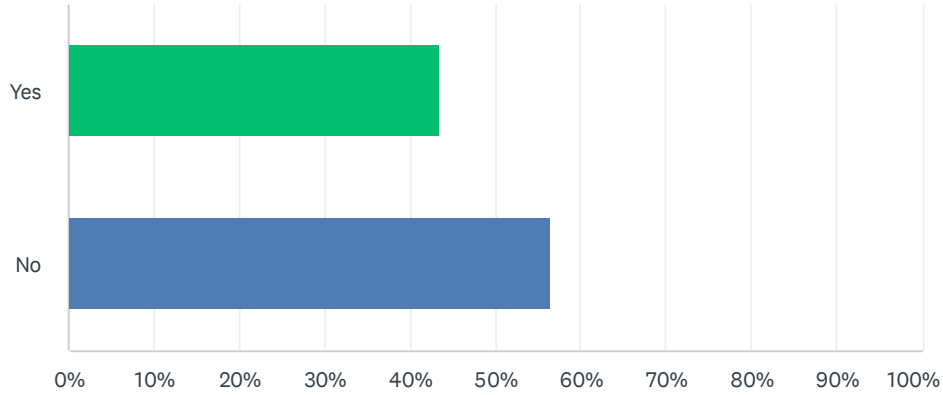

Q20 Building costs for the new library are projected to exceed the original estimates. Are you in favor of the town contributing additional funds toward the completion of the library?

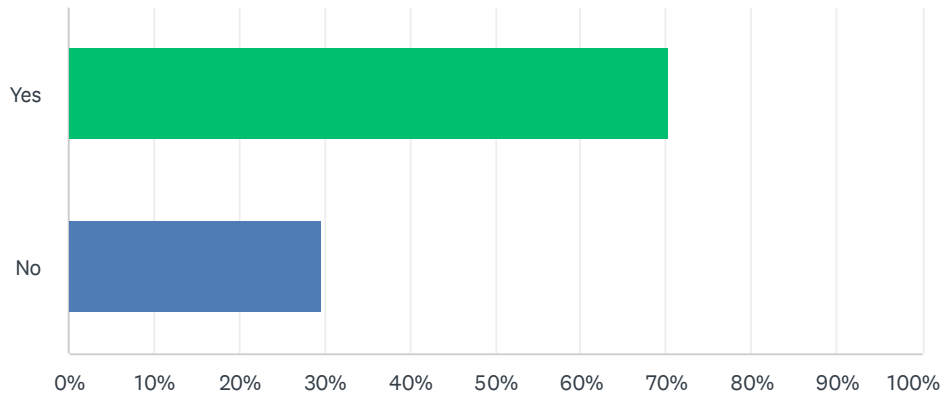

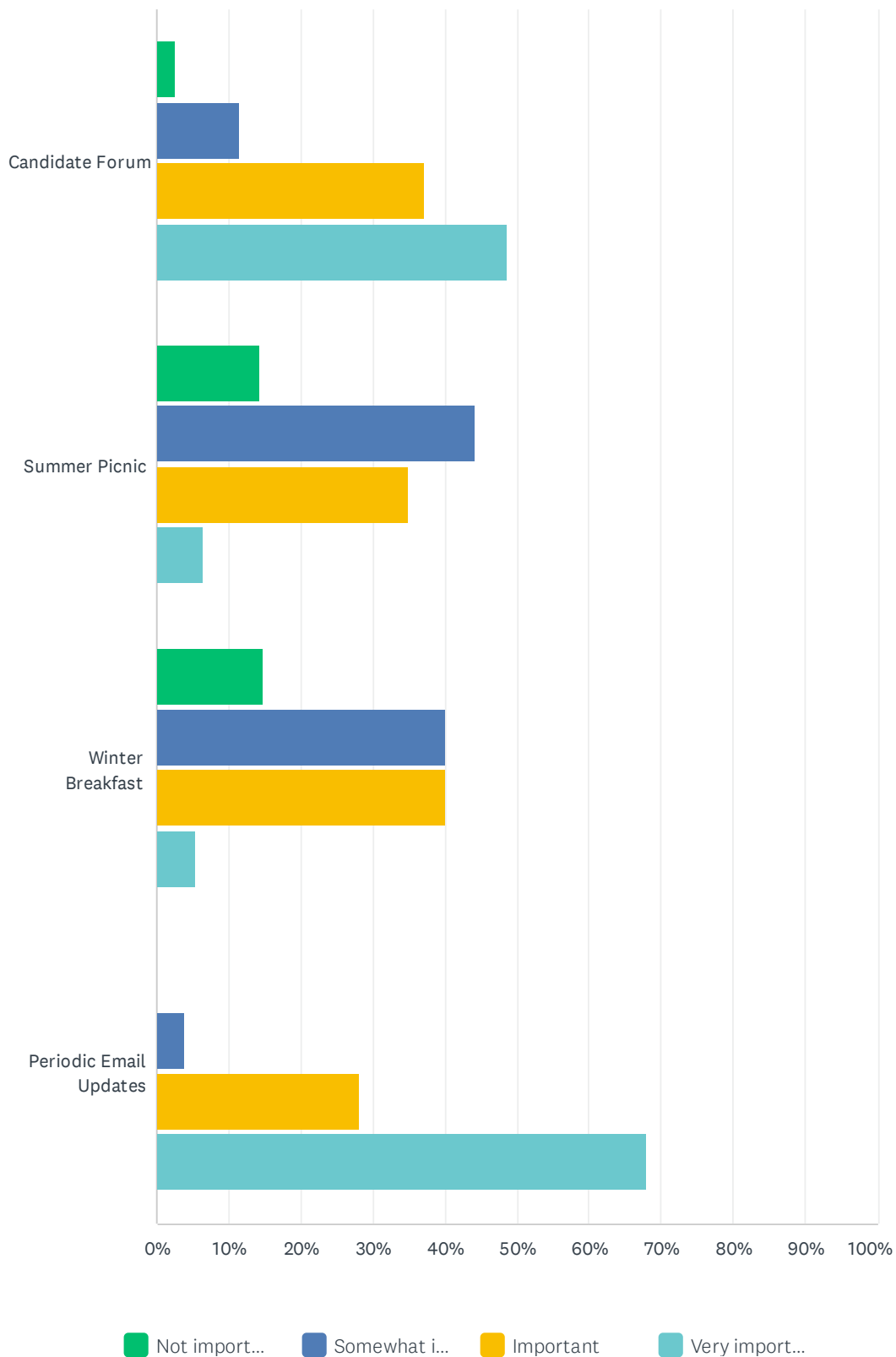
